

### 10.Front Sub Sensor

#### A: REMOVAL

- 1) Turn the ignition switch to OFF.
- 2) Disconnect the ground cable from battery and wait for at least 20 seconds before starting work.
- 3) Remove the front grille and the front grille side. <Ref. to EI-38, REMOVAL, Instrument Panel Assembly.>
- 4) Disconnect the connector from front sub sensor.



5) Loosen the nut and remove the front sub sensor.



#### **B: INSTALLATION**

Install in the reverse order of removal.

#### **CAUTION:**

- Do not reuse the bolt and nut.
- Always use new bolts and nuts for them.

#### Tightening torque:

Refer to "COMPONENT" of "General Description". <Ref. to AB-2, SRS AIRBAG, COMPONENT, General Description.>

### C: INSPECTION

Check for the following, and replace the damaged parts with new parts.

- Front sub sensor, mounting bracket and connector are damaged.
- Airbag is deployed.
