# 7. Airbag Control Module

## A: REMOVAL

CAUTION:

• Do not disassemble the airbag control module.

• If the airbag control module is deformed or if the damage from water is suspected, replace the airbag control module with a new part.

• Do not drop the airbag control module.

• After removal, keep the airbag control module on a dry, clean surface away from moisture, heat and dust.


1) Turn the ignition switch to OFF.

2) Disconnect the ground cable from battery and wait for at least 20 seconds before starting work.
3) Remove the console cover. <Ref. to EI-37, RE-MOVAL, Console Box.>

4) Remove the center console panel. <Ref. to EI-38, REMOVAL, Instrument Panel Assembly.>

5) Disconnect the connector from airbag control module.

6) Remove four bolts.



### **B: INSTALLATION**

#### CAUTION:

- Do not reuse the bolt and nut.
- Always use new bolts and nuts for them.

• Be sure to put the water protection cover over the connector.

Install in the reverse order of removal.

### Tightening torque:

Refer to "COMPONENT" of "General Description". <Ref. to AB-2, SRS AIRBAG, COMPO-NENT, General Description.>

### **C: INSPECTION**

Check for the following, and replace the damaged parts with new parts.

- Control module, connector, and mounting brack-
- et are damaged.
- Airbag is deployed.
- Side airbag is deployed.
